We are planning to develop the former Pen-Y-Cwm School site. The plan is to have health and wellbeing facilities including a 3G pitch and grassed area, with a community kitchen and engagement room provision. We will be working to develop a community allotment and garden area.

We are very excited at the development of this area which will greatly enhance our school grounds.
